Upon receipt of this signed Warranty Deed, the LLBC will record this in County, WI and will pay the recording fee. In order to not have to send to a PO Box, if you send it to my home address that may speed up the process. My address is

After receipt and recording of the Deed, LLBC will calculate the amount we need to refund you from your prepaid <u>YEAR</u> Maintenance Assessment (MA) fee which you paid <u>DATE/YEAR</u> and therefore, you are paid up through March 31, 20 If we receive the Deed back prior to <u>DATE</u> , 20 we will refund youmonths of the 20MA fee. If any MA or other fees to LLBC are outstanding, the total amount dues plus accrued interest will be deducted from the amount of the land contribution value computed in item #1 above.
4. Upon receipt of the deed and, if you have already paid the current year's property taxes on said property, LLBC will reimburse you the remaining prorated property taxes to December 31, 20 If the taxes are unpaid, they must first be paid by you (along with any late fees and/or interest) before LLBC can accept the deed.
